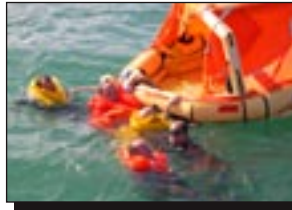
The training includes hands-on drills in the classroom, the pool, and the open-water, using aviation-specific equipment and procedures to increase survivability in water survival emergencies.
